To All Exemptions' Beneficiaries

It has been noticed with great concern that exemptions approvals are collected without making formal declaration of the goods exempted. This has always resulted in distortion of statistical data of imported goods.

By this notice, all beneficiaries of exemptions are required to attached a duly completed declaration to the exemption application. The completed declaration should be signed and stamped by a LICENCED Clearing agent registered in the Customs service. No exemption application will be processed without a declaration and not signed by an agent

This arrangement takes effect from Nov. 1, 2013, and adherence to it is required.
