**Subject: Tax Exemption for Humanitarian Goods**

In order to effectively respond to the humanitarian crises and meet the current needs of the affected population, the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission strongly advise you to Plan accurately and improve your supply chain management of humanitarian commodities. Any goods for immediate humanitarian response must be indicated clearly and must be submitted at least 2 working days before the goods arrive the Country.

The RRC Directorate of NGOs Affairs is more than ready to process/facilitate the exemptions of your commodities within a reasonable timeframe (Max 2days) from the date of submission. This circular acts as a reminder and must be taken seriously. Please address your request to:
