Notice to Register All VSAT Terminals in Use in South Sudan

Ministerial Order Number 2012/01

In accordance with the powers conferred upon me by Article 114[2] of the Transitional Constitution of South Sudan (2011) and in pursuance of Articles 18[1] and 19[1] of the Telecommunication Act (2001) together with Sections 36[1] and 37[1] of the Telecommunication Corporation Act (2004):-

I, Hon. Maj. Gen. Madut Biar Yel, Minister for Telecommunication and Postal Services, do hereby issue this **Ministerial Order Number 2012/01** instructing all Private VSAT (Small Satellite Dish or Terminal) Users and Internet Service Providers (ISPs) to register with the Ministry of Telecommunications & Postal Services, Directorate of Telecommunications, Juba Town, within **two (2) weeks** from the date of Order. Failure to comply with the set deadline will lead to immediate shutdown of the services as provided for in the legal authorities cited above.

United Nations (UN) Agencies and Foreign Missions are exempted from this requirement.
