## REF: REQUEST FOR OPERATIONAL CERTIFICATE IN SPLM/A TERRITORY

Dear Humanitarian Partners.

Reference to 6-12 December 2014 Pagak Conference Resolutions, Part 2 section (22), all NGOs and Humanitarian Agencies who are operating in SPLM/A controlled areas should be require to obtained their registration from SSRRA National Office. Based on this resolution, the South Sudan Relief and Rehabilitation Agency (SSRRA) hereby issue the following:

- 1. All Humanitarian Agencies and NGOs must have a PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE OF OPERATION in the SPLM/A controlled areas;
- 2. Registration fees of \$100 US Dollars for International NGOs and \$50 US dollars for National NGOs and all payments should be done by the NATIONAL OFFICE HQs, Pagak, South Sudan. The PROVISIONAL CERTIFICATE OF OPERATION is valid for Six months ONLY.
- 3. All Humanitarian agencies, UN personnel and NGOs who are coming from Juba to SPLM/A controlled areas must have an ACKNOWLEDGMENT LETTER from SSRRA National HQs, Pagak, South Sudan;
- 4. ALL Humanitarian agencies, UN personnel and NGOs must SEEK PERMISSION before their arrival to SPLM/A territory:
- 5. All <u>INTERNATIONAL STAFF</u> who are travelling to SPLM/A territory areas MUST pay \$20.00 **USD** for a period of three months as a Travel Permit and permit will be <u>ISSUE</u> on the <u>ARRIVAL</u>;
- 6. All NATIONAL STAFF who are working with NGOs and UN personnel in the SPLM/A controlled areas are require to pay 10% of their basic salaries as a National contribution to the SSRRA National Office through States SSRRA Offices;
- 7. All IMPORTED ITEMS FOR PROJECTS ARE EXEMPTED FROM TAXES from local CUSTOMS Offices except value added tax (VAT) for local purchased items.

NB: All National NGOs who did not received any grants, are exempted from this registration.

The registration of NGOs/ humanitarian agencies and the above mentioned requirements will start on Monday, the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2015 from 10:00am to 4:30pm. For more details, please do not hesitate to contact the Office of Executive Director at RRA HQs, Pagak. ( strue P. /horst)
