Republican Order No.23/2016 for the **Formation of the Humanitarian High Level Oversight Committee**, 2016 A.D.

1. TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT:

This Order shall be cited as "The Republican Order No.23/2016 for the **Formation of the Humanitarian High Level Oversight Committee**, 2016 A.D.," and shall come into force on the date of its signature by the President of the Republic.

2. THE ORDER:

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Article 101 (j) of the Transitional Constitution of the Republic of South Sudan 2011, I, Salva Kiir Mayardit, President of the Republic of South Sudan, do hereby issue this Republican Order for the **Formation of the Humanitarian High Level Oversight Committee** composed of the following Members as hereunder:-

3. THE TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE COMMITTEE:

The Terms of Reference for the Committee shall be as hereunder:-

- 1. To ensure that the NGO desk operates effectively without restrictions;
- To remove all road blocks and illegal imposition of taxes on the humanitarian convoys;
- To instruct and direct all states and local governments to cooperate with humanitarian personnel;
- 4. To render any available assistance to officials and personnel engage in process of conducting humanitarian services.

- 5. To ensure that persons found to obstruct delivery of humanitarian assistance shall face the full force of the law; and
- 6. The committee may co-opt other members as they deem necessary.
