This is to notify all NGOs operating in the Republic of South Sudan that the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC), Office of Registrar General of NGOs would like to advise all NGOs having staff without work permit and planning to travel to the project sites in the field MUST notify RRC in seventy two (72) hours before the actual intended date of travel.

For now, the head of the organizations should write a covering letter addressed to the Registrar General of NGOs requesting for clearance of such staff travelling with no work permit, indicate their names, position and locations they intend to go to.

Currently, the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) is coordinating with the Ministry of Labour, Public Services and Human Resource Development to resolve pending issues of work permits.
