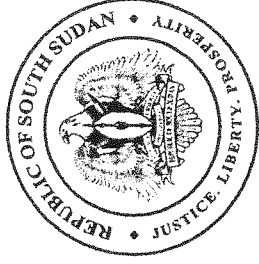

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS**  
**Resolution No.25/2016**

Subject: **Unified Motor Vehicles Number Plate and Driving License Data**  
**System Registry**

After deliberating on the presentation made by the Acting Minister of Interior and Wildlife Conservation on the above subject,

The Council of Ministers in its Extraordinary Meeting No. 02/2016 held on Wednesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2016, resolves to approve with some minor amendments the proposal of the Acting Minister of Interior and Wildlife Conservation for introduction of a Unified Motor Vehicles and Number Plate System and Driving License Data System and Registry. The amendments include the removal of the Coa of Arms, reduction of the digits on the number plate from four to three and addition of letter S (standing for Service) to the initials preceding the digits, as per the memo No.RSS/MOI/WC/ODM/1/7/129 dated 21<sup>st</sup> January 2016.

The Ministries of Cabinet Affairs; Interior and Wildlife Conservation shall take the necessary measures to implement this resolution.
