RRC CIRCULAR NO 01/2018.

On behave of Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC); I am writing to notify all NGOs operating in the Republic of South Sudan that registration fee of both International Nongovernmental Organizations and National Organizations in South Sudan has been waived for the year 2018.

Due to current humanitarian situation and huge burden of funding many humanitarian projects in the country, the President of the Republic of South Sudan H. E Gen. Salva Kiiir Mayardit directed the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) to waive registration fees for year 2018 for all NGOs.

In the light of the above directives; I. Mr. Deng Tong Kenjok, Registrar General of NGOs Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) do hereby issue this particular circular exempting registration fees of all National and International Non-governmental Organizations (NGOs) operating in the Country for the year 2018 effective from today 24/01/2018.

The commission shall continue to implement all registration requirements in the NGOs Act, 2016. However; all NGOs shall be required to pay service and administrative fees payable to RRC.
