Subject: Registration of VSAT.

All VSAT that are operating within the territory of South Sudan are required to be registered with the National Communication Authority as per section 27(1) and 28(1) of the Communication Act 2012. In addition to that, only the licensed ISPs are allowed to provide VSAT services to clients in South Sudan.

Any other operator not mentioned in the list attached is operating illegally and in contravention of section 98 of the Act.

The registration fee to be paid by the **end user** is as indicated in the table below.

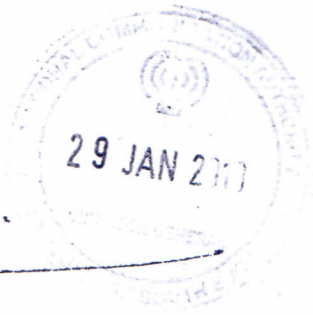
