Re: Relocation of the Headquarter of the National Committee for Humanitarian Affairs to Juba

The headquarter of the National Committee for Humanitarian Affairs is to relocate immediately to Juba and to start coordinating from there the humanitarian and relief work in the SPLM/SPLA(IO) administered till when the Revitalized TGONU is established. You will coordinate these matters in collaboration with the Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs and Disaster Management as well as with the United Nations Agencies and NGOS.

The ROSS offices abroad shall continue coordinating relief efforts as well.

On the other hand, I have agreed with the Deputy Special Representative of the UN Secretary General to South Sudan and with the heads of the UN agencies who had a meeting with me in Khartoum today 11th November 2018 to assist you convene in Juba a workshop for ROSS State Directors in order to resolve any impediments in access and delivery of relief to our people.

In the light of the above meeting, the circular ED-ROSS/NCHA/2017/003 dated 22nd October 2017 is hereby put on hold. All ROSS Directors in South Sudan and as well as the country directors abroad are to comply accordingly.
