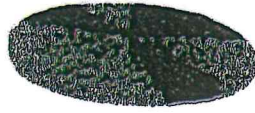

South Sudan National Revenue Authority Taxpayer Database development

The South Sudan Revenue wishes to inform the general public that, the Authority is on the process of building a new taxpayer database in the Republic of South Sudan. This is part of the revenue modernization and tax policy reforms geared towards diversifying the revenue source from near dependency on oil revenue.

The National Revenue Authority inauguration on 2nd March, 2018 is a testament to the resolve and political will of the South Sudan government to seriously leverage the economic situation to expand social service.

The new database is to enable the Authority provide efficient taxpayer services to the business community and the public in general.

In this regard, the National Revenue has developed taxpayer data collection form which is available in the Head Office of the **National Revenue Authority at Jebel opposite the National Security Building.**

According to the World Bank, the economy of South Sudan is one of the world's most underdeveloped and the most oil-dependent. The government has embarked on tax reform to revise the situation and shift the economy from over reliance on oil revenue.

The completion and submission of this data collection form is mandatory for businesses, Humanitarian organizations and NGOs.
