Subject: CID Circular Dated 28/05/2019

This is to notify all NGOs operating in the Republic of South Sudan that the Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) office of Registrar General of NGOs would like to advise all humanitarian agencies not comply with CID circular issued on 28/05/2019.

The CID office of economic and finance crimes are not mandated to regulated the work of NGOs in the Republic of South Sudan under the NGOs Act, 2016. CID department of economic and finance is only mandated to oversee issues of, alien supervision registration certificate, stamp approval and letter of no objections under financial act, 2018/2019 but not mandated to request for RRC registration certificate, list of NGOs' staff, area of NGOs operations and projects from partners.

Taxation matters could be managed under the National Ministry of Finance and Economic planning and Immigration related could be handled under Department of Nationality Passport and Immigration (DNPI). In case CID officers appear in your compound over the circular; please refer them to RRC for further clarifications.
