The Relief and Rehabilitation Commission (RRC) presents its compliments to the Country Directors and Head of Missions of International Non-Governmental Organizations (INGOs) and the National Non-Governmental Organizations (NNGOs) operating in the Republic of South Sudan.

Travel Authorization letter was used by RRC to facilitate movement of NGOs staff with no work permits on temporary basis. Now the commission will continue to provide temporary travel authorization letters to only visiting staff of the organizations for a period of 3weeks.

Consultants and other staff on temporary assignments of the organization, and will stay in South Sudan for 1 month and above, could seek assistance from the Undersecretary of Labor and Industrial Relations, National Ministry of Labor, Public Service and Human Resources Development.

In the light of the above; I kindly advise our partners to comply and follow rightful procedures in regards to this circular.
