REF: LIFTING OF PERSONAL INCOME TAX (PIT) PAYMENT SUSPENSION IN THE  
DEFUNCT 32 STATES

In reference to the meeting held between H.E. the Vice President of Gender, Youth and  
Humanitarian Affairs and Hon. Minister for Humanitarian Affairs and Disaster Management  
and in consultation with the Economic Cluster. The resolved to lifting the Ministerial Order  
No.2/2020 regarding the cancellation of PIT payment to the defunct 32 states.

Therefore, I am here to inform all the NGOs and UN Agencies in the country to continue  
remitting PIT to the defunct 32 States accounts with immediate effect as follows:

1. The February - June 2020 PIT Arrears shall be paid to the defunct 32 states accounts  
as they have been operational during the mentioned period;
2. The PIT payment to the Ten (10) States that shall be further regulated by the ten  
States Governors who are to be appointed soon.
