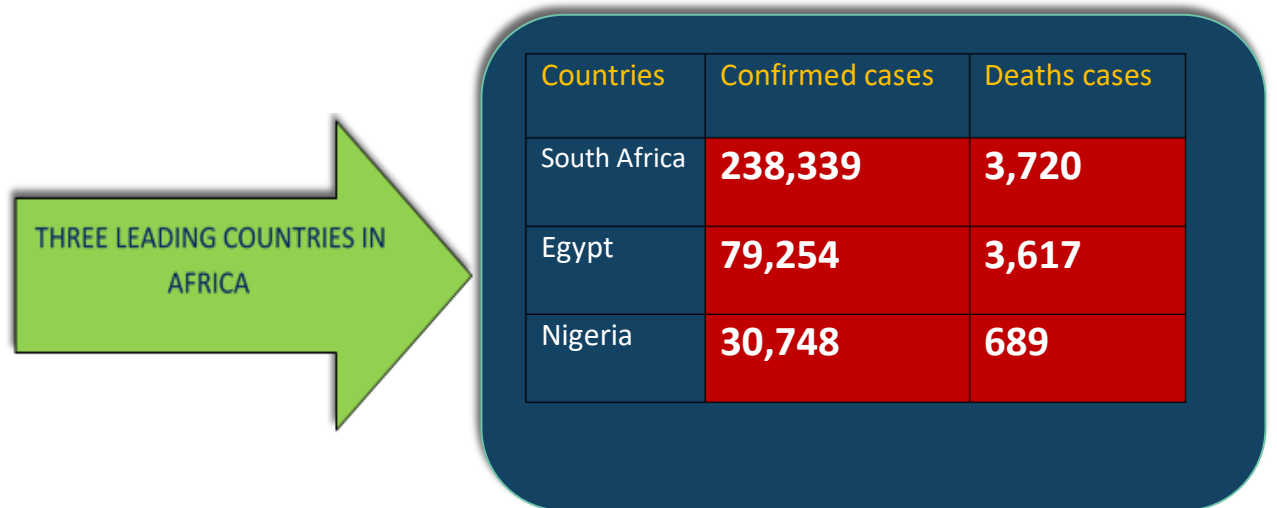

Ebola Outbreak in Congo Declared Over

Nearly 2 years after the Democratic Republic of the Congo's (DRC's) longest and biggest outbreak began,

the country's health officials today [Thu 25 Jun 2020] declared that the event in the eastern part of the country is over.

The outbreak, which was the DRC's 10th, began on 1 Aug 2018, was the world's 2nd-largest, and began just a week after a small 11-week outbreak

in the country's northwestern Equateur province was declared over. And now the event is bookended by a

fresh outbreak in the same area of Equateur province.

In a statement today [Thu 25 Jun 2020], the WHO congratulated the DRC and all groups that helped end the outbreak. WHO Director-General

Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus, PhD, said in a statement, "The outbreak took so much from all of us,

especially from the people of DRC, but we came out of it with valuable lessons and valuable tools. The world is now better equipped to respond to

Ebola. A vaccine has been licensed and effective treatments identified."

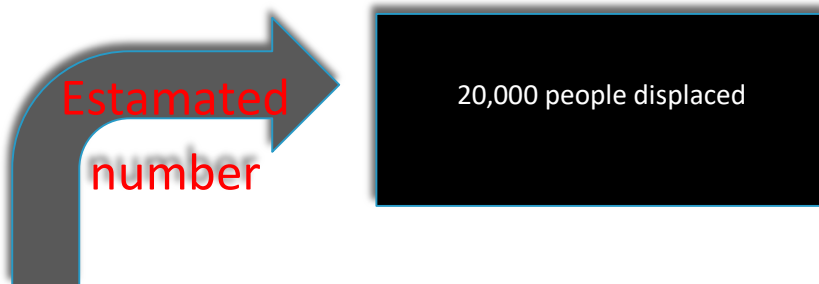
