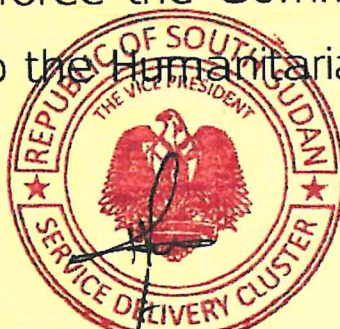

Re: **Lifting of Restrictions on Movement**

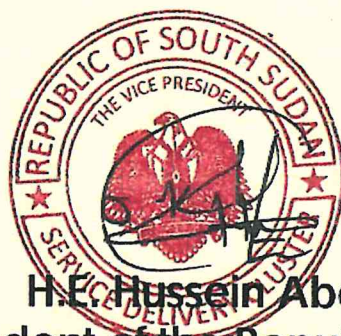
The National Taskforce on Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic in its Communiqué number 75 held on Wednesday, 26th August 2020, permitted UN and all humanitarian organizations to move freely without any restrictions once already in the country with the view that they have undergone mandatory fourteen days self-isolation to allow them respond to emergencies.

Meanwhile the Government Institutions at all levels, are urged to strictly enforce the Communication and accord due cooperation to the Humanitarian Organizations as this



will save lives and livelihoods of communities across the Country which are devastated by the recent floods and displacement due to ethnic fighting. These challenges have been further compounded by the outbreak of seasonal vector-borne diseases, malaria, typhoid, Bilharzias, Pneumonia to mention a few.
