GUIDELINES FOR COVID19 SAMPLES COLLECTION AND TESTING FOR TRAVELERS AND MEDICAL REFERREALS

COVID19 test samples for travelers should be collected based on their dates of travel to avoid expiration of COVID19 results. This will be done as follow:

- Those who are traveling on MONDAY, their samples should be taken on SATURDAY
- Those who are traveling on <u>TUESDAY</u>, their samples should be taken on <u>SUNDAY</u>
- Those who are traveling on <u>WEDNESDAY</u>, their samples should be taken on <u>MONDAY</u>
- Those who are traveling on <u>THURSDAY</u>, their samples should be taken on <u>TUESDAY</u>
- Those who are traveling on FRIDAY, their samples should be taken on WEDNESDAY
- Those who are traveling on <u>SATURDAY</u>, their samples should be taken on <u>THURSDAY</u>
- Those who are traveling on <u>SUNDAY</u>, their samples should be taken on <u>FRIDAY</u>
