



Following consultations among stakeholders, the Inter-Cluster Coordination Group (ICCG), Humanitarian Country Team (HCT), and humanitarian agencies recommended and endorsed below labor rates for different categories of casual workers inside IDP / protection of civilian sites (PoCs) sites. The official UN exchange rate of 1 USD for the month of March 2021 is 177.37 SSP.

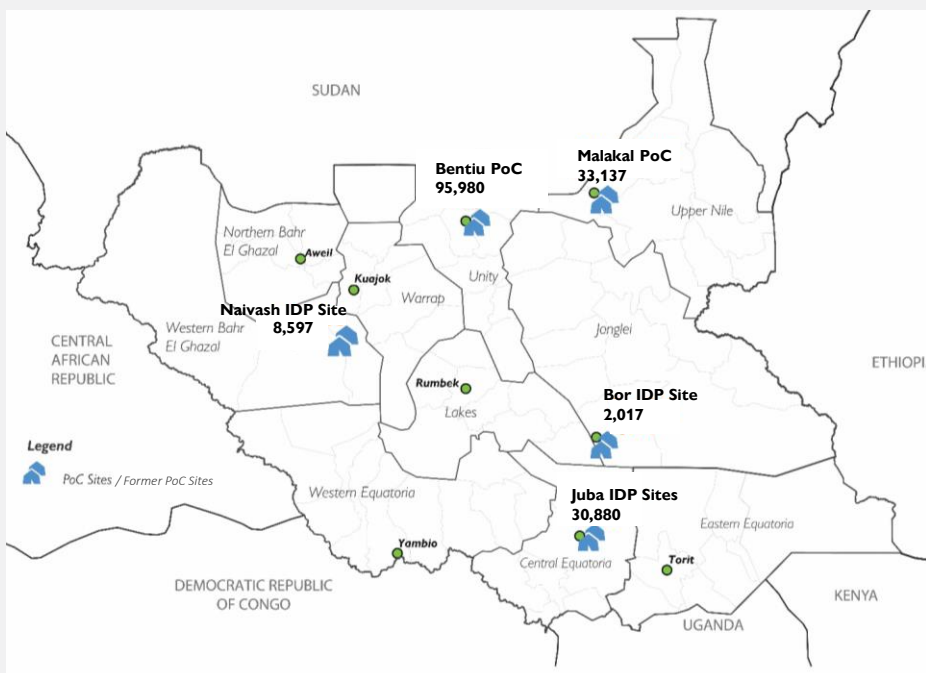
