REF: LABOUR MARKET ASSESMENT IN EASTERN EQUATORIA STATE

The National Ministry of Labour present its compliments to the State Governor of Eastern Equatoria State and would like to draw your attention to the above mentioned subject. We have been called for a meeting held in the Ministry of Humanitarian Affairs and Disaster Management to discuss concerns raised by the UNOCHA representing all the UN agencies and NGOs Forum and RRC. The concerns were around the Labour Market Assessment that is taking place in Eastern Equatoria State. Some sections of the tools are not currently applied.


Since the Headquarter of the UN agencies and the NGOs are based in Juba, they have expressed their willingness to provide all their workers data to the Ministry here in Juba. Once provided we will share the findings with your State.

I am therefore requesting your good office to suspend the process of data collection for the time. We will coordinate with your state to conduct the Labour Market Assessment together, this will entail identifying the data collectors and giving them the necessary training on how to use the tools.

The Ministry of Labour, on half of the National Government of the Republic of South Sudan avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the state government of Eastern Equatoria State, the assurance of its highest consideration.
