**Re: Implementation of Electronic Cargo Tracking Note (ECTN) Certifications.**

I would like to present my compliments, honor, and privileges to write to you on the subject thereof.

Allow me to introduce and welcome you all to the 2021 implementation of the Electronic Cargo tracking certificate (ECTN) in the Republic of South Sudan.

As per the Circular letters from the Vice President and Chairman of the Ministerial Economic Cluster, the Republic of South Sudan, H.E Prof. James Wani Igga (Ph.D.), dated 2nd of Feb 2021, K-polygone Multinational SSD LTD has signed a Trade Facilitation Portal Agreement with the Government of the Republic of South Sudan through the Electronic Cargo Tracking Note (ECTN) Certification to support, enhance & increase Government's Revenue Collection and keep the statistical records of all goods entering in and going out of the region of South Sudan.

Le Comex Afrique Ltd is the official representative and implementing partner of K-Polygone Multinational SSD LTD and it is in charge of all imports, exports, and transit certificates for the entry points including but not limited to Juba International Airport, Nimule, Kaya, and Nadapal.

As per the circular letter dated 13/4/2021 from the Director-General of Customs of National Revenue Authority, the South Sudan Customs Division has mandated K-Polygone Multinational SSD LTD through Le Comex Afrique Ltd to cover all cargo entering South Sudan with the Electronic Cargo Tracking Certificates. All shippers, forwarders, and clearing agents that represent all the NGOs and Humanitarian organizations are required to present the

ECTN certificate at the entry point to Le Comex Afrique Ltd for verification and customs clearance.

The ECTN must be issued and validated at the loading port before the shipment starts from the port of origin and are liable for import clearance by South Sudan Customs Division, any cargo without the ECTN certificate is NOT supposed to be cleared through the local customs with a possible fine fee and demurrage fee penalty until a valid ECTN is done but because K-Polygone Multinational SSD and Le Comex Afrique LTD understand the humanitarian situation and some emergencies that have always submerged the humanitarian organizations, we have been issuing emergency ECTNs to all humanitarian organizations through their clearing agents a practice we cannot continue to do.

We kindly advise your office to address this with the humanitarian organizations to apply for the ECTN/FCC certificate through their clearing agents or over our websites and emails as given below or contact us on the below email addresses or visit us at the Airport Road, SADECO Building, Office#303 to avoid disruptions of your activities.
