Re: **Mandatory COVID-19 Test and Vaccination.**

The National Taskforce on Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic, in its 15<sup>th</sup> deliberations held on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> October 2021, resolved:

1. To carry mass testing to both public and private institutions through Rapid Diagnostic Tests, to gauge the level of infections in the country.
2. To carry mass vaccination program in all the public and private institutions. This is to caution all the institutions furthermore that in the next few months to come, traveling outside might require mandatory COVID-19 vaccine certificates.
3. To adhere to the Standard Operation Procedures (SOPs) such as; mandatory wearing of the facemask, maintaining social distancing, provision of sanitizers, washing hands regularly with soaps and avoiding crowded places. These are valuable tools to minimize infections.



4. The Audit Committee in the National Taskforce shall conduct routine inspections to all the institutions to ensure compliance.

Therefore, all the head of the public and private institutions are urged to comply and immediately without hesitations, implement the order with the help of the Ministry of Health.
