Re: Suspension and withdrawal of Training Request and Application Form of RRC

On 7th April, 2022, RRC issued circular RSS/RRC/HQRS/J/DGPTR/36/15 regarding introduction of NGOs Training Request and Application Form to obtain clearance for National and International NGOs that intend to conduct Workshops, Conferences, Seminars, Consultative meetings, Conventions, Submits, Public Lectures, Debates, Discussions and Field Research. The new procedures have shifted away considerable amount of resources and energy from intended goals and objectives which may slow down humanitarian response amid rising Humanitarian Needs across South Sudan.

RRC will continue to promote the spirit of collaboration and cooperation for effective and efficient humanitarian response to save lives. It is therefore in this context that the leadership of RRC has resolved to suspend and withdraw the aforementioned form and reverts to previous clearance procedures without any fee.
